SJR___ NAMING BOTH BRIDGES ON INTERSTATE 22 THAT SPANS
MULBERRY FORK IN WALKER COUNTY, ALABAMA, THE SENATOR GREG
REED BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, it is with the highest accolade that this
body honors Senator Greg Reed by requesting the State
Department of Transportation designate both bridges on
Interstate 22 that span Mulberry Fork in Walker County,
Alabama, as Senator Greg Reed Bridge; one bridge runs
southeast while its companion runs northwest; and

WHEREAS, Senator Greg Reed was born in Jasper and
grew up in Cordova in Walker County; he graduated from
Walker County public schools and attended Walker College,
now Bevill State Community College; he earned his bachelor's
degree from The University of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Senator Greg Reed's career in public service
began in 2010, when he was elected to the Alabama Senate; he
was reelected in 2014 and 2018; his Republican colleagues
elected him Majority Leader at the start of the new
legislative term in 2015; in 2021, he served as the Alabama
Senate's President Pro Tempore with integrity and
distinction until November 2024 when he joined Kay Ivey's
administration as Senior Advisor to Workforce
Transformation; and

WHEREAS, Senator Greg Reed focused his sponsored

29 legislation on Medicaid reform, economic development,
30 workforce transformation, and rural enhancement; key 2024
31 legislation included the "Working for Alabama" package, the
32 Alabama Growth Alliance Act, and education-related
33 transparency, which boosted workforce participation and
34 rural development; he continues to greatly impact the
35 success of Alabama's workforce in his current role as
36 Secretary of the Department of Workforce; now therefore,

37 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
38 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That to honor former Alabama
39 Senator Greg Reed, who served the State of Alabama with
40 integrity and distinction as a legislator and continues to
41 positively impact the state's workforce as the first
42 Secretary of the Department of Workforce, the State
43 Department of Transportation is encouraged to coordinate
44 with local governing officials to consider designating both
45 bridges on Interstate 22 that span Mulberry Fork in Walker
46 County, Alabama, the Senator Greg Reed Bridge and to erect
47 appropriate signs or markers, consistent with applicable
48 requirements and laws, in recognition of this designation.
