SJR___ NAMING THE PORTION OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 9 FROM MT. HEBRON ROAD TO BOSWELL ROAD IN ELMORE COUNTY THE LAMAR S. "BUBBA" WOODHAM, JR. HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, it is with the highest accolade that this body honors Lamar S. "Bubba" Woodham, Jr. by requesting the State Department of Transportation designate the portion of Alabama Highway 9 from Mt. Hebron Road to Boswell Road in Elmore County, Alabama, the Lamar S. "Bubba" Woodham, Jr. Highway; and

WHEREAS, Bubba Woodham was born in Montgomery in 1953; he graduated from Sidney Lanier High School and matriculated to Auburn University where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering; and

WHEREAS, Bubba Woodham continued a generational legacy when he began his career with the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) as a laborer in a survey party, working summers while attending high school and college; he progressed through multiple ALDOT bureaus, including Materials and Tests, Maintenance, Design, Engineering Services, Office Engineer, Right-of-Way, Assistant Chief Engineer for Administration, and Deputy Director of Administration, retiring after more than 47 years of dedicated service to the State of Alabama; and
