1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to St. Clair County; providing for an
3 additional expense allowance and salary for the coroner and
4 deputy coroner.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

6 Section 1. (a) Commencing on October 1, 2024, the
7 Coroner of St. Clair County shall be entitled to an additional
8 expense allowance in the amount of five hundred twenty-five
9 dollars (\$525) per month, which shall be in addition to all
10 other expense allowances, compensation, or salary provided by
11 law. This expense allowance shall be payable monthly from the
12 general fund of the county.

13 (b) Beginning with the expiration of the term of the
14 incumbent coroner, the expense allowance for the coroner
15 provided in subsection (a) and any other expense allowance
16 provided for the coroner prior to the effect date of this act
17 shall be converted to salary, payable monthly from the general
18 fund of the county and at that time subsection (a) and any
19 other expense allowance provided to the coroner prior to the
20 effective date of this act shall become void.

22 Section 2. (a) Commencing on October 1, 2024, the
23 Deputy Coroner of St. Clair County shall be entitled to an
24 additional expense allowance in the amount of two thousand six
25 hundred dollars (\$2600) per year, which shall be in addition
26 to all other expense allowances, compensation, or salary
27 provided by law. This expense allowance shall be payable
28 monthly from the general fund of the county.

29 (b) Beginning with the expiration of the term of the
30 incumbent coroner, any expense allowance for the deputy
31 coroner provided in subsection (a) and any other expense
32 allowances provided for the assistant coroner or deputy
33 coroner of the county by any names known prior to the
34 effective date of this act shall be converted to salary and at
35 that time subsection (a) and any other expense allowance
36 provided to the deputy coroner or the assistant coroner shall
37 become void. The position shall be known as the Deputy Coroner
38 of St. Clair County and the salary shall be payable monthly
39 from the general fund of the county

40 Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
41 1, 2024, upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
42 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
