22	Section 1. Act 2023-560 of the 2023 Regular Session,
23	now appearing as Sections 16-65A-1 through 16-65A-7,
24	inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, establishing the Distressed
25	Institutions of Higher Education Revolving Loan Program, is
26	repealed.
27	Section 2. (a) Any funds in the Distressed Institutions
28	of Higher Education Loan Program Fund shall be transferred to

29	the Education	Trust	Fund	within	30	days	of	the	effective	date
30	of this act.									

- 31 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
 32 contrary, funds transferred to the Education Trust Fund
 33 pursuant to subsection (a) shall be considered nonrecurring
 34 revenue for purposes of Chapter 9 of Title 29, Code of Alabama
 35 1975, and available for supplemental appropriation for the
 36 fiscal year ending September 30, 2024.
- 37 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately.
