5	ORGANIZATION AND TO REJECT ANY INTERNATIONAL HEALTH
6	REGULATIONS REGARDING PANDEMIC PREPAREDNESS.

8	WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) has
9	proven itself to be a corrupt organization that has hampered
10	worldwide public health efforts; and
11	WHEREAS, the WHO has a history of mismanagement and
12	scandals, including the cover-up of severe sexual abuse by
13	its staff in the Democratic Republic of the Congo following
14	an Ebola viral outbreak; and
15	WHEREAS, the WHO is an opaque organization
16	unaccountable to the United States government despite
17	receiving between \$200 and \$600 million annually in United
18	States taxpayer subsidies over the past decade; and
19	WHEREAS, as an organization, the WHO has chosen to
20	place in positions of leadership on its executive board
21	representatives of extreme authoritarian regimes such as the
22	People's Republic of China, the Democratic People's Republic
23	of Korea, the Syrian Arab Republic, and Belarus in complete
24	disregard for the human rights abuses regularly committed by
25	these regimes; and
26	WHEREAS, at the beginning of the COVID-19 outbreak
27	and throughout the pandemic, WHO officials were complicit

with the government of the People's Republic of China in

29	preventing international understanding of the virus and its
30	effects and in covering up its origins, thereby increasing
31	the severity of the pandemic and its death toll; and
32	WHEREAS, the WHO is currently in the process of
33	drafting new International Health Regulations and a proposed
34	Pandemic Preparedness Treaty that will further expand the
35	organization's authority and empower unelected international
36	bureaucrats through a "One Health" mandate to override
37	national sovereignty in areas including energy, agriculture,
38	climate, and public health; and
39	WHEREAS, granting the WHO such authority would
40	empower authoritarian regimes, contribute to the theft of
41	intellectual property, erode the sovereignty of western
42	democratic nations in favor of an international technocracy,
43	and threaten western liberal democracy; and
44	WHEREAS, the United States has its own Centers for
45	Disease Control and Prevention to address issues of domestic
46	and international public health and disease preparedness, an
47	organization that is accountable to the people of the United
48	States and their elected representatives; now therefore,
49	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
50	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the members of this body
51	encourage the United States representatives and senators
52	elected by the people of the State of Alabama to take all
53	steps necessary and reasonable to permanently end taxpayer
54	funding of the World Health Organization.
55	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of this body
56	encourage the President of the United States and his foreign

57 policy officials to reject the creation of any policy, law, 58 convention, or regulation, whether through amendments to the International Health Regulations or through the drafting of 59 an international agreement regarding Pandemic Preparedness, 60 61 that would in any way further empower this ineffective and corrupt organization. 62 63 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of this body 64 encourage the United States government to ensure the fundamental freedoms of the American people against the 65 66 corrupting influence of international entities such as the World Health Organization that all too often are under the 67 influence of authoritarian foreign regimes that do not act 68 in the best interest of the United States. 69
