30	authority to permit or disallow use of maritime data collected
31	for use in pilotage of vessels within the waters of the State
32	of Alabama, unless the data is developed by an agency of the
33	United States or approved by the commission. Maritime data
34	produced by foreign states or by a foreign or domestic company
35	must be expressly preapproved by the commission for any
36	official use in pilotage.
37	(b) The commission shall also have the power and
38	authority to may require evidence of the physical and mental
39	fitness of any active bar pilot at any time and to make adopt
40	rules-and regulations regarding the physical and mental
41	capacity and fitness of the active bar pilots."
42	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
43	1, 2024.
