10	This bill would provide for retroactive effect
11	and would automatically repeal on April 1, 2025.

15	TO BE ENTITLED
16	AN ACT
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18	Relating to in vitro fertilization; to provide civil
19	and criminal immunity to persons providing goods and services
20	related to in vitro fertilization in certain circumstances; to
21	provide retroactive effect; and to provide for the repeal of
22	the act on a certain date.
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law,
25	including any cause of action provided in Chapter 5 of Title
26	6, Code of Alabama 1975, no action, suit, or criminal
27	prosecution shall be brought or maintained against any
28	individual or entity providing goods or services related to in

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29	vitro fertilization except for an act or omission that is both
30	intentional and not arising from or related to IVF services.
31	(b) This section is intended to apply retroactively.
32	(c) This section is repealed on April 1, 2025.
33	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately.
