4 Relating to animals; to amend Section 3-1-28, Code of
5 Alabama 1975, to further provide the methods by which dead
6 animals may be disposed.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 3-1-28, Code of Alabama 1975, is
9 amended to read as follows:

10 "§3-1-28

11 All owners or custodians of animals ~~which~~ that die or
12 are killed in ~~their~~ his or her possession or custody, other
13 than ~~such as are~~ those slaughtered for food, within 24 hours
14 shall ~~cause the bodies of such animals to be burned or~~ burn,
15 ~~buried~~ bury at least two feet below the surface of the ground,
16 or otherwise dispose of the animals' bodies in accordance with
17 Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries rules. ~~Hogs~~
18 ~~dying from cholera or any other disease whatsoever shall be~~
19 ~~burned.~~ No ~~such~~ animal shall be ~~burned or,~~ buried, or disposed
20 of sufficiently near a residence ~~or residences~~ as to create a
21 nuisance. Any ~~person~~ individual violating this section,
22 whether by failure to ~~burn or,~~ bury, or dispose of an animal,
23 ~~dying or being killed in his possession~~ or by causing the ~~same~~
24 animal to be burned in such proximity to a ~~dwelling~~ residence
25 or in such other way as to become a nuisance, shall be guilty
26 of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, shall be fined not more
27 than fifty dollars ~~(\$50).00."~~

28 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
