9	Relating to labor organizations; to condition an
10	employers' eligibility for economic development incentives
11	upon the employer refraining from certain practices relating
12	to employee representation by a labor organization; and to
13	provide oversight.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. For purposes of this act, the following
16	words have the following meanings:
17	(1) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE. A grant, loan, or
18	tax credit provided by the state or local government to an
19	employer, not including any incentive made pursuant to Article
20	13 of Chapter 23 of Title 41, Code of Alabama 1975.
21	(2) EMPLOYEE. An individual who performs services for
22	an employer for wages that are subject to withholding
23	requirements under 26 U.S.C. §3402.
24	(3) EMPLOYER. A person or entity that voluntarily
25	pursues an economic development incentive and enters into an
26	agreement with the state or local government for the purpose
27	of receiving the incentive.
28	(4) LABOR ORGANIZATION. The same meaning as provided in



29 Section 25-7-2, Code of Alabama 1975.

30 (5) PERSONAL CONTACT INFORMATION. An individual's home 31 address, home phone number, cell phone number, or personal 32 email address.

33 (6) PROJECT. The activity or enterprise for which an34 employer receives an economic development incentive.

35 (7) SECRET BALLOT ELECTION. A process conducted by an
 agent of the National Labor Relations Board in which an
 amployee casts a secret ballot for or against labor
 organization representation.

39 (8) SUBCONTRACTOR. A person that has contracted with an40 employer to perform work or provide services.

41 (b) No employer shall be eligible to receive an
42 economic development incentive for a project if the employer
43 does any of the following:

44 (1) Voluntarily grants recognition rights for the
45 employer's employees solely and exclusively on the basis of
46 signed labor organization authorization cards if the selection
47 of a bargaining representative may be conducted through a
48 secret ballot election.

49 (2) Voluntarily discloses an employee's personal
50 contact information to a labor organization, or third party
51 acting on behalf of a labor organization, without the
52 employee's prior written consent, unless otherwise required by
53 state or federal law.

54 (3) Requires a subcontractor to engage in activities55 prohibited by subdivision (1) or (2).

56 (c) An employer that engages in any activity prohibited

57 by subsection (b) shall be required to repay all economic 58 development incentives received over the life of the project. (d) This section shall not apply to any agreement 59 60 between the state and an employer executed prior to January 1, 61 2025. 62 (e) This section shall not apply to any employer with a 63 collective bargaining unit where an employer, as of October 1, 64 2024, has entered into a collective bargaining agreement for 65 that collective bargaining unit with a labor organization or to which a secret ballot election has already occurred under 66 67 applicable federal law.

(f) The Alabama Department of Revenue may investigate
potential violations of subsection (b) of Section 1 and
enforce the provisions of this section.

71 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October72 1, 2024.
