4	Relating to state-at-large notaries public; to add
5	Section 36-20-70.1 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to provide
6	that both individuals who are licensed professionals and their
7	employees who are commissioned as notaries public may lawfully
8	perform notarial acts that are required in the practice of
9	their profession.
10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
11	Section 1. Section 36-20-70.1 is added to the Code of
12	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
13	\$36-20-70.1
14	(a) For purposes of this section, the term
15	"professional service" means any service or occupation that
16	may be lawfully performed only pursuant to a license issued by
17	a state court, state regulatory licensing board, or other
18	similar agency, and the term "professional" refers to an
19	individual who holds the license.
20	(b) Notwithstanding Section 36-20-70, Code of Alabama
21	1975:
22	(1) A professional who is commissioned as a notary
23	public, in the normal course of providing a professional
24	service in exchange for a fee, commission, or other payment,
25	may perform any acknowledgment or other notarial act that is
26	required to provide the professional service; and
27	(2) An individual who is employed by a professional and
28	who is commissioned as a notary public may perform any

29	acknowledgment or other notarial act that is required in the
30	normal course of providing a professional service for which
31	the employing professional receives a fee, commission, or
32	other payment.
33	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
34	1, 2024.
